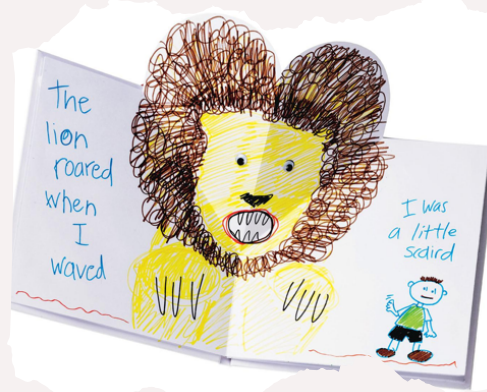




6 KID-FRIENDLY WORKSHOPS FOR GRADE 1 – GRADE 7
